Background

Maharashtra is one of the leading fruits and vegetables producing states in India. It has emerged as one of the country's largest exporters of fruits and vegetable crops. In terms of production, the State accounts for 11% of total fruits and 5% of total vegetables produced in the country. Despite ample opportunities for Maharashtra's horticulture growth that contributes to poverty reduction of farmers, they face challenges related to the agricultural sector's structural issues such as small and marginal land holding, lack of access to direct marketing and interference by middlemen. This leads to below par returns for the farmers in the state.

About MAGNET: The Government of Maharashtra in association with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) is co-financing Maharashtra Agribusiness Network Project (MAGNET) to upscale the development of horticulture sector and agribusiness in Maharashtra. The project core objectives are to increase farmers' income, support value addition, reduce post-harvest losses, increase farm productivity, and mainstream opportunities for rural women lower caste to alleviate rural poverty. The project aims to focus on 15 targeted horticulture value chains which includes, Banana, Okra, Pomegranate, Guava, Orange, Sweet Lime, Sapota, Custard Apple, Strawberry, Mango, Lemon, Cashew Nut, Green and Red Chilies, Snake Gourd and Flowers.

Components of the Project: The focus of the project is on 3 core outputs namely:

- a. **Output 1**: Institutional capacities of agribusiness institutions and farmer producer organizations strengthened.
- b. **Output 2**: Financial and agribusiness capacities of farmer producer organizations and value chain operators strengthened.
- c. **Output 3**: Agriculture value chain infrastructure improved and operational for the target horticulture crops.

Requirement and Potential for nurseries

Cultivation of traditional fruit crops comprising tropical and sub-tropical fruits like pomegranate, orange, sweet lime, etc has the potential to provide sustainable livelihood to the small land holders both under irrigated as well as rainfed conditions. However, timely availability of good quality planting material for these horticulture crops and absence of standardization and certification are the major issues in the promotion of area expansion under these crops. The demand far exceeds the production from the government nursery units. Thus, there exists good scope for establishing commercial nursery production unit to meet. Since good quality planting material fetch a premium price, investment in a commercial nursery unit is considered to be a viable and profitable proposition. Hi-tech nursery involves growing of plants in protected environment consisting of polyhouse and net house.

An expression of interest will be floated to invite proposals. The selection is a one stage process and the submitted DPRs will be evaluated to finalize the beneficiaries.

Eligible Organizations

a. Farmer producer Organizations (FPOs)

- Farmer Producer Organizations (FPO is farmers organizations registered under the Companies Act, 2013; State Co-operative Societies Act; Farmer Groups promoted by ATMA/ Cluster Level Federations (CLFs) promoted by MSRLM/ Community Managed Resources Centers (CMRCs) promoted by MAVIM also including Cluster Level FPO Federations/Associations)
- Anchor FPOs identified under MAGNET project.

Note: Preference will be given to women led/women owned entities from the above category applicants

Eligibility Criteria of Farmer producer Organizations (FPOs)

 Legally registered FPOs- Farmer Producer Companies, Farmer Cooperative Societies, and other Producer Organizations (Legal Entities) also including Cluster Led FPO Federations/ Associations. If FPO is not a legal entity then at the time of application, it should apply for legal registration and should be legally registered at the time of grant agreement.

- Minimum membership strength of 250 farmers with annual turnover of at least Rs.
 5.00 Lakhs in at least one audited financial statement in last 3 years with positive net worth.
- However, for Associations/ Federations minimum shareholding of 10 institutional members with an aggregate shareholder base of minimum 2000 producers
- FPO should be a legally registered entity, with audited books of Accounts (audited by a Chartered Accountant) for at least 1 year.
- FPO should not have been declared as Non-Performing Asset (NPA) by Bank/ FI
 due to past loan default.
- FPO should not have any significant adverse audit observations in its previous annual audits.

b. State Agriculture Universities (SAUs) and ICAR assisted Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVKs)

Eligibility Criteria of State Agriculture Universities (SAUs) and ICAR assisted Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVKs)

- The participating institutions must be a legal entity as per Indian law.
- The research institute should have experience in successful management of any kind of farmer support services (e.g. Agricultural machinery custom hiring center, inputs supply, procurement center, extension services etc.)
- The institution should be eligible for receiving government funds/grants.
- The research institute or university should have requisite networking and linkages with other academic and research institutions to take advantage of existing expertise.

Evaluation of Proposals

a. Evaluation Process

In order to invite applications for matching grant on setting up of hi-tech nursery, MAGNET Society proposes the following.

It is proposed to invite application for DPR from potential applicant organizations. This will be through publication of advertisement of EoI in the State level newspaper (Both English and Marathi) and on MSAMB and MAGNET website along with prescribed application form. The potential applicants will need to download the prescribed form from MSAMB or MAGNET website after registration. They may also

collect the form from PIU/MSAMB Division Office. The application form, DPR and supporting documents are to be submitted in **soft copy format only**, via email to projectadb@msamb.com.

- The selection will be a one step process. The application form and supporting documents will be scrutinized to shortlist eligible proposals.
- These proposals will then be scored as per the scoring criteria defined in Appendix V and VI.
- The proposals will be ranked basis the scores received and the DPRs of top ranked applicants will be evaluated.
- The DPRs will be technically and financially appraised and evaluated by PISC. For each DPR, eligible project cost and corresponding Matching Grant amount will be apprised and determined by PISC and accordingly PISC will recommend it to Technical Committee of PMU.
- The proposals will then be placed for review in front of the Technical Committee and subsequently the Governing Council of MAGNET Society.
- The Project Director, MAGNET will then issue administrative approval order to the projects sanctioned by the Governing Council cum Sanctioning Committee. MAGNET Society will enter into grant agreement with beneficiaries of the sanctioned projects. Subsequently, Matching Grant will be released as per terms and conditions of the grant agreement. Monitoring and evaluation of the project will be done as per the guidelines of grant agreement and implementation guidelines with the help of PISC

b. Scoring Criteria

 All eligible applications will then be scored as per the scoring criteria defined in Appendix V and Appendix VI. A cumulative score will be arrived at for each applicant. The DPRs of the applicants passing the minimum cut-off (50 marks out of 100) will be scrutinized. Also, it will be ensured that equitable distribution among MAGNET focused crops and inclusion of women led/owned beneficiaries is encouraged.

c. Approval from Technical Committee and General Council

 All eligible and top ranked applications will be then appraised and evaluated by the PISC and then placed before the Technical Committee and Sanctioning Committee for final approval and sanction.

d. Evaluation Committee

- There will be 2 levels of evaluation for approval of applications. These include Technical Committee (TC) and Governing Council (GC).

Monitoring and evaluation of the subproject will be done as per the guidelines of grant agreement and implementation guidelines with the help of PISC.

List of Ineligible Sub Projects as per ADB's Safeguard Policy Statement

a. Subprojects that are on the ADB's Prohibited Investment Activities List (PIAL) per Safeguard Policy Statement 2009.

The exclusion list supports the proper execution of the Environmental and Social Risk Assessment Procedure. The MAGNET Society will not provide financial assistance, invest in, lend to, or engage in harmful activities to the environment, harmful or dangerous to people or communities. In particular, the following activities will not be supported:

- i. Any activity classified category "A" and/or "B" for (a) involuntary resettlement, and "A" for (b) indigenous peoples in accordance with ADB's safeguard policy statement.
- ii. Production or activities involving harmful or exploitative forms of forced labor or child labor.
- iii. Production or trade in any product or activity deemed illegal under the Indian laws or regulations or international conventions and agreements, or subject to international phase outs or bans, such as (a) pharmaceuticals, pesticides, and herbicides, (b) ozone-depleting substances, (c) polychlorinated biphenyls and other hazardous chemicals, (d) wildlife or wildlife products regulated under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, and (e) trans boundary trade in waste or waste products.

- iv. Production of or trade in weapons and munitions, including paramilitary materials.
- v. Production of or trade in alcoholic beverages, excluding beer and wine.
- vi. Production of or trade in tobacco.
- vii. Loans associated with individual gambling, casinos and equivalent enterprises.
- viii. Production of or trade in radioactive materials, including nuclear reactors and components thereof.
- ix. Production of, trade in or use of unbonded asbestos fibers.
- x. Commercial logging operations or the purchase of logging equipment for use in primary tropical moist forests or old-growth forests.
- xi. Marine and coastal fishing practices, such as large-scale pelagic drift net fishing and fine mesh net fishing, harmful to vulnerable and protected species in large numbers and damaging to marine biodiversity and habitats.
- xii. Mining activities.
- xiii. Activities involving genetically modified organisms.

Eligible Project Cost

- The eligible project cost will be calculated considering the cost norms of eligible components including applicable taxes. The project will use cost norms as defined by MIDH.
- The eligible project cost will be calculated considering the following –
- Proper fencing.
- Scion / Mother block of improved varieties.

- Root stock block (Rhizome bank in case of bamboo).
- Shade Net house
- Irrigation facilities
- Hi-tech greenhouse having insect proof netting on sides and fogging and misting systems.
- Hardening/maintenance in insect proof net house with light screening properties and sprinkler irrigation system.
- Pump house to provide sufficient irrigation to the plants and water storage tank to meet at least 2 days requirement.
- Soil solarization steam sterilization system with boilers.
- Goods and Services Tax (GST) on eligible components
- It should be ensured that the critical components required to set up functioning of a hitech nursery must be included in the project proposal.
- Applicants to take into consideration that the cost of greenhouse/polyhouse plus the cost of shade house/shade net should be in the range of 50-60% of the total proposed project cost.

Pattern of Assistance

- The financial assistance available under the project is in the form of matching grant. The maximum admissible grant for each approved project will be up to 60% of eligible project cost subject to maximum of Rs. 60 lakh per project for a maximum of 4 Ha. as project-based activity on pro rata basis.
- Each nursery will produce a minimum of 50,000 numbers per hectare of proposed MAGNET focused crop duly certified for its quality.
- The disbursement of the matching grants proceeds to the sanctioned beneficiary organization will take place in three installments (mentioned below) and in accordance with the disbursement schedule and will be subject to meeting the necessary conditions.

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 Detailed disbursement schedule and compliances will be elaborated in the subsidy agreement.

Project Proposal Selection Criteria

- a. Projects should include only establishment of new hi-tech nurseries.
- b. Proposal should be for non-tissue culture propagation and adhere to MAGNET crops only
- c. Proposal should be technically sound and financially viable as well as have satisfactory environmental and social safeguards.
- d. Proposal must adhere to MAGNET's Environmental and Social Safeguards.
- e. Projects proposing to set up their infrastructure outside Maharashtra will not be considered.
- f. Land title in the name of the applicant or land lease, duly registered with the competent authority for not less than the period of 15 years will be required.
- g. Projects shall confirm to the state and local development plans and shall not include projects that are restricted or prohibited.
- h. All compliances/ permissions/ documentation/ clearances/ NOCs/ Certificates etc. as required by the concerned departments/authorities of the government norms etc. must be complied.
- i. Submission of all documents which will include among other documents- DPR, Estimates/ Quotations, Undertakings etc.

Specific conditions

- a. Grants will be extended only for projects duly approved by MAGNET Society.
- b. Final selection for assistance to any entity will be based on meeting of eligibility and scoring criteria and final discretion of MAGNET Society for approval.
- c. Only Projects appraised by Technical Consultant (appointed by MAGNET Society) and approved by MAGNET Society will be given grant sanction.
- d. MAGNET Society may use their sole discretion to reject any project/any specific component that is eligible under specific grant schemes of other institutions like NHB, RKVY, SMART, POCRA, etc. The idea here is to complement the existing schemes and not to compete with them. For example: Some applicants may be

- eligible for grant scheme of NHB/MIDH for one of the components proposed in the project. Such applicants shall not be considered for the same component under MAGNET, unless otherwise allowed by MAGNET Society.
- e. Applicant can avail assistance under this scheme in conjunction with other schemes being implemented by Central Ministries/Departments or State Government. However, no assistance will be provided for the projects that have already been approved/availed Capital Grant Assistance on same components from any other Central Govt. /State Govt. Agencies/Departments.
- f. Not more than one application from the same applicant / company will be entertained. An application will be considered as second proposal if there are cross holdings of the promoter(s)/partner(s) between two applicants/entities.
- g. All equipment of the project should be new. Reconditioned/ refurbished equipment will not be eligible for subsidy.
- h. Expansion/Upgradation of the existing facility (ies) will not be entertained.
- i. The subsidy will be restricted only on the eligible components created after the date of issue of Expression of Interest [Eol].
- j. During the implementation, project promoters will not be allowed to drop/remove/reduce capacity of any item approved for subsidy. If circumstances may still require such action on behalf of promoter, the revised project will be considered/ rejected for grant approval only after appraisal by Technical Consultant and approval of MAGNET Society.

Production or trade in any product or activity deemed illegal under the Indian laws or regulations or international conventions and agreements, or subject to international phase outs or bans, such as (a) pharmaceuticals, pesticides, and herbicides, (b) ozone-depleting substances, (c) polychlorinated biphenyls and other hazardous chemicals, (d) wildlife or wildlife products regulated under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, and (e) transboundary trade in waste or waste products
- 5. Production of or trade in weapons and munitions, including paramilitary materials
- 6. Production of or trade in alcoholic beverages, excluding beer and wine
- 7. Production of or trade in tobacco
- 8. Loans associated with individual gambling, casinos and equivalent enterprises
- 9. Production of or trade in radioactive materials, including nuclear reactors and components thereof
- 10. Production of, trade in, or use of unbonded asbestos fiber.
